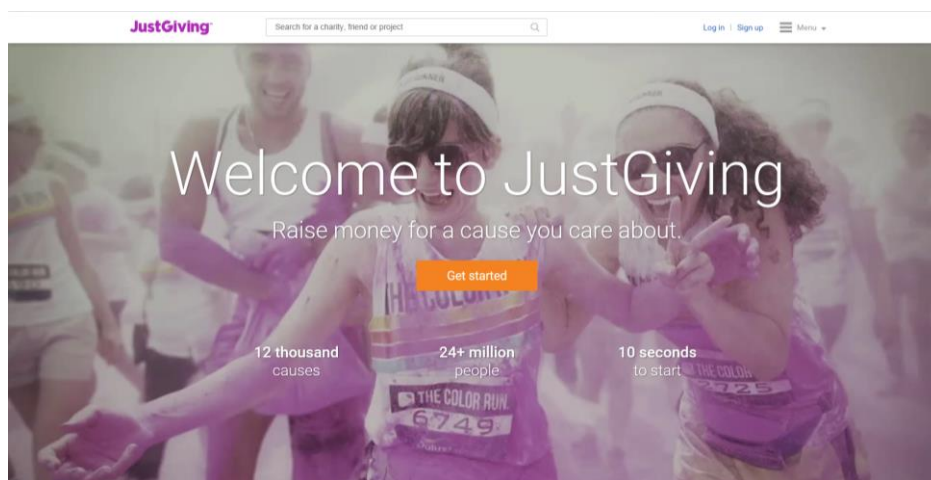


How to set up your own fundraising page using Just Giving

You can create your own page to fundraise for Brandon Trust from the JustGiving homepage (www.justgiving.com)

To create your page, just follow these steps:

1. Click **Get started** on the JustGiving homepage



2. Log in to your JustGiving account - If you don't have an account, enter your email address and click **Continue** to set one up and fill in the required details (your name, email, create a password, and address) and click **Sign Up**.

3. Search for and select Brandon Trust

4. Let JustGiving know what you're doing to raise money - Are you taking part in an **Organised event**, celebrating a **Personal occasion**, raising money **In memory** of someone or taking on your own **Personal challenge**?

6. **Finalise your selection** - Let JustGiving know if you're doing an event or challenge in memory of someone, if the charity is contributing to

the cost of your fundraising, and if you'd like to stay up-to-date with your charity's news and JustGiving's news
